LOCAL LAW 5-2008

**RESOLUTION #137**

Motion made by Councilwoman and seconded by Councilman Hack, resolve the Town of Holland approve the following Local Law 5-2008:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW 2-1988 "ADOPTION OF CODE", ADOPTED JULY 13, 1988 BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HOLLAND, AS AMENDED, TO PROVIDE FOR A MORATORIUM IN REGARD TO THE USE AND CONSTRUCTION OF WIND FARM PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HOLLAND AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT**

This Local Law amends Local Law 2-1988, known as “Adoption of Code”, adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Holland on July 13, 1988, as amended, relating to the administrative, legislative and general legislation of codes within the Town of Holland as herein set forth.

**SECTION 2. ARTICLE III, REGULATIONS WHICH APPLY TO ALL DISTRICTS**

Section 120-8 is amended by adding the following:

A moratorium on the construction and use of wind energy conversion systems shall be effective for a period of six (6) months from the date of the adoption of this local law.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State
